Friday - Tonka Pride or wear Blue (Kindergarten - **lots of colors or your favorite** color)

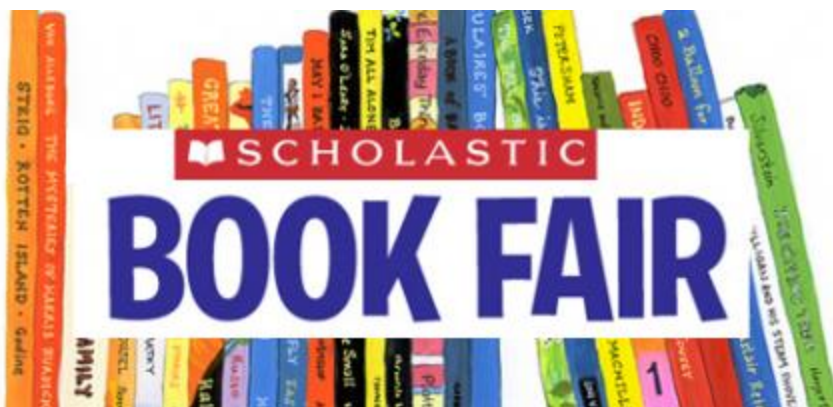


Skyward

Entering Absence Requests

If you know of a future absence for your student(s), you can complete an absence request in Skyward by following the steps below:

1. Go to Skyward and click on Attendance from the left column.
2. From Attendance, click on Enter Absent Request.
3. From here, each of your children will be listed. Click on Add Request for the child you are entered an absence for.
4. Enter Start Date – Time, End Date – Time and the Reason and optional Comments
