Thank You PTA! The PTA Executive Board approved a **record-breaking \$91,107** in enrichment grants this December. The Fall grant process was new this year as was the special budget. Spring Teacher Grants will still take place following The Minnetonka Public Schools Foundation grant program, and the budget will be more in line with the Deephaven PTA's typical grant budget of \$10,000 - \$30,000 based on fundraising income. Enrichment support provided by our PTA directly impacts our students and their learning opportunities.
