The Minnetonka Public School District is among the highest performing school districts in Minnesota—and the nation.

Minnetonka High School graduates 98 percent of its students, and 90 percent are college-bound. The Class of 2018 posted an average ACT Score of 27.7, with nine students from the class of 2018 earning a top score of 36.



TECHNOLOGY AND STEM COURSES RAISE ACHIEVEMENT



Minnetonka is a national leader in putting **educational technology tools** in the hands of students and master teachers. We are the first district in Minnesota to offer K-5 computer coding curriculum. Grades K-8 have HUB Maker and Coder Spaces (Minnetonka Foundation Endowment Project) that support creative, handson learning experiences around technology, design, making and engineering.

Our **1:1 iPad® program** (grades 5-12) offers digital curriculum, collaborative tools and planning applications.

Students can complete and submit homework, download books, watch recorded lessons, take notes and complete quizzes and assessments directly from the iPad. Highly trained staff use technology to personalize learning.

Our innovative curriculum equips students with the knowledge to solve problems, gather evidence and make sense of information by studying science, technology, engineering and math—subjects collectively known as STEM.

WORLD-CLASS FINE ARTS BUILD SELF-ESTEEM

Minnetonka is committed to excellence in Fine Arts and has been named one of the **Best Communities for Music Education** by the NAMM Foundation.

Classroom and choral music instruction begin in Kindergarten. Students can participate in instrumental music in grades 4 (orchestra) and 5 (orchestra or band). Small group and individual lessons are available to help students excel in vocal and instrumental music. Our high school choirs and orchestras perform and compete locally, nationally and internationally.

Students can also **develop their passion for the arts** through drawing and painting, art and design, 3D art, woods, creative writing and drama—all available as 8th grade electives.

Studio art students learn artistic expression through art production, art history and aesthetics.

Musicals are offered in our elementary, middle and high school. Minnetonka Theatre is recognized as one of the premier programs in the Midwest. It prepares cast and crews to be creative, critical thinkers, successful scholars and advocates for the arts.

At Minnetonka Preschool, children explore the world around them and grow in a safe environment that focuses on **social, emotional and cognitive development**. Preschool curriculum aligns with District curriculum, making the transition to Kindergarten smooth and familiar.

Minnetonka is one of just three school districts in Minnesota (and roughly 70 school districts in the nation) with a Moody's Aaa Bond Rating—the highest bond rating possible for any government or corporate entity.

School Board Policy directs **77% of the District's annual operating budget to instruction**. District administration consumes only 4% of the budget.

Buildings are **renovated** for long-term use and collaborative learning. Thanks to generous **private community funding**, kids enjoy modern sports fields and facilities. In 2015, voters approved local operating & technology funding which is expected to provide budget stability through 2025.
